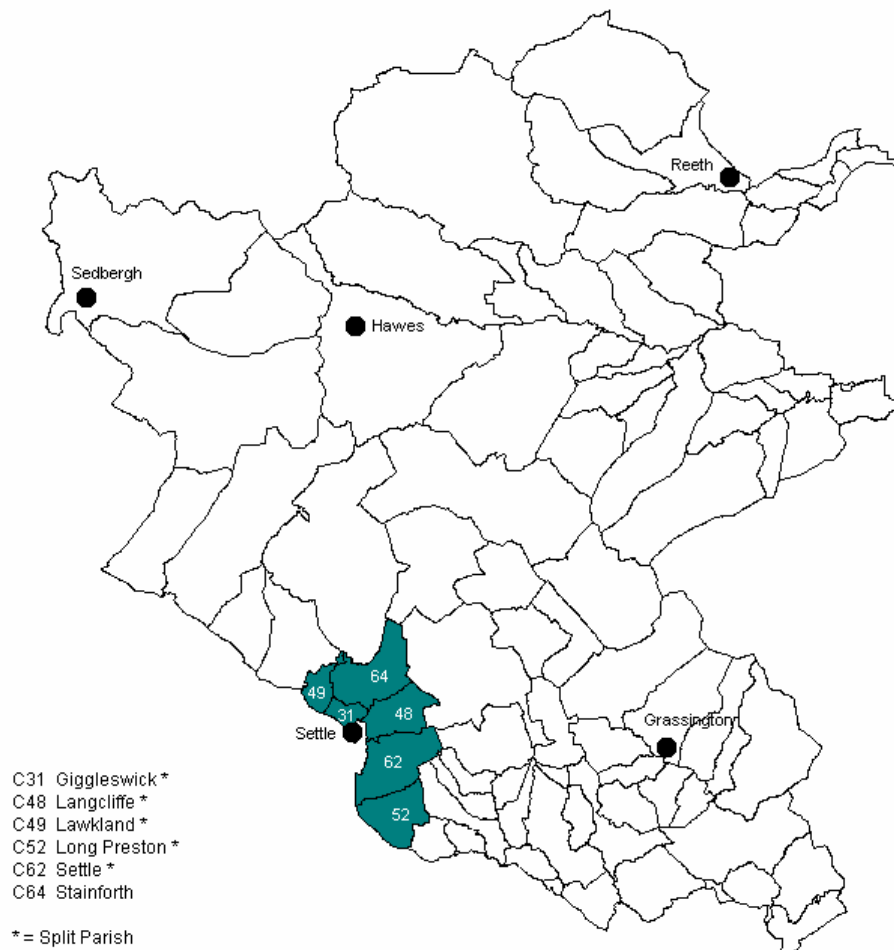


LOWER RIBBLESDALE CENSUS PROFILE 1991-2001



(Parishes of Giggleswick, Langcliffe, Lawkland, Long Preston, Settle, Stainforth)

(NB: all parishes in this grouping are split by the NP boundary except Stainforth, this may distort NP information).



NOTES

1. Figures may not sum due to independent rounding and adjustments to preserve confidentiality.
2. Any parish that falls below the confidentiality threshold for Small Area Statistics data is merged with a contiguous parish. (Confidentiality threshold in 1991 was 50 persons/20 households, in 2001 the threshold was 100 persons/40 households).
3. Where parishes are split by the National Park boundary and/or combined with others outside the boundary, an estimate has been made of the percentage in the Park.

Summary

Very high increase in population

Increase in all sectors, proportionately greater increase in children than those of the pensionable age sector

Considerable increase in number of households. Growth in all household types. Household size stable.

Considerable growth in number of new dwellings (Long Preston, Stainforth). Increase in outright ownership

Moderate growth in economic activity

High levels of service jobs.

Balanced distribution of occupations.

Low numbers working from home (non-agricultural). High levels of car commuting.

Large growth in numbers of cars (36%)

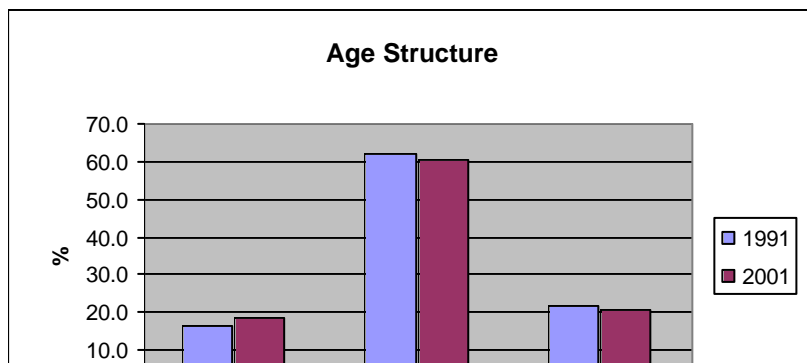

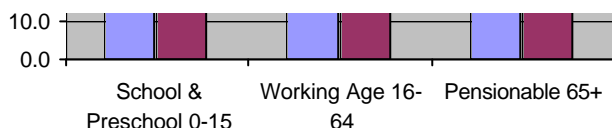
