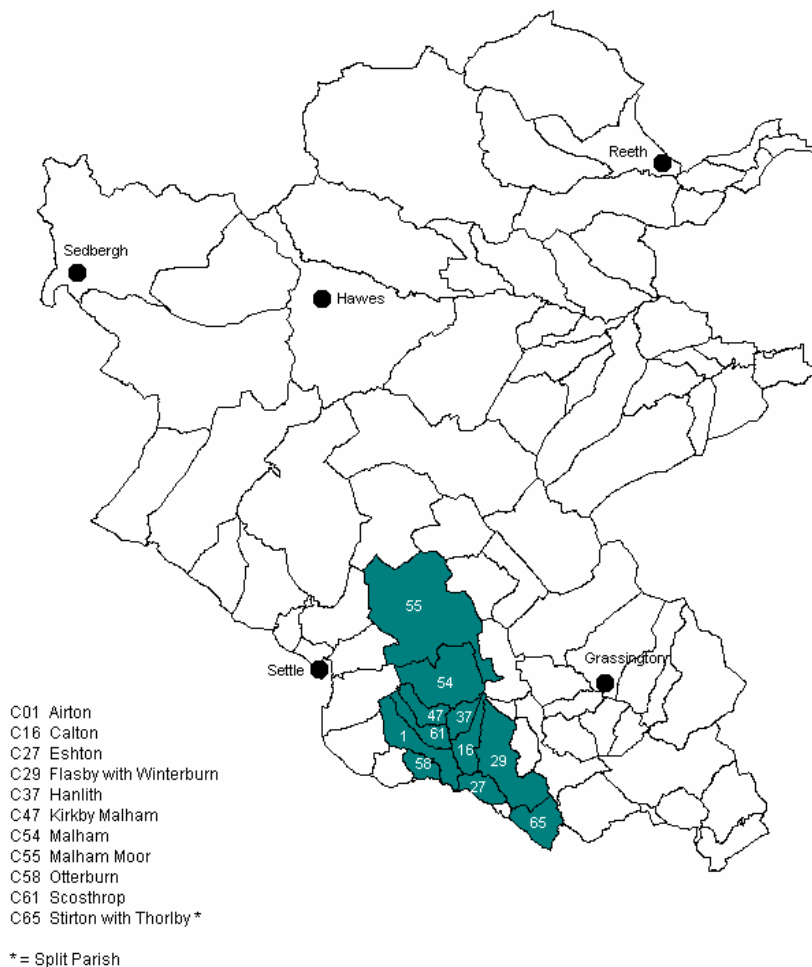


MALHAMDALE CENSUS PROFILE 1991-2001

(Parishes of Airton, Calton, Eshton, Flasby-w-Winterburn, Hanlith Kirby Malham, Malham, Malham Moor, Otterburn, Scosthrop, Stirton with Thorlby)

Data includes Bordley in 1991 but not in 2001 due to restricted data).



Notes

1. Figures may not sum due to independent rounding and adjustments to preserve confidentiality.
2. Any parish that falls below the confidentiality threshold for Small Area Statistics data is merged with a contiguous parish. (Confidentiality threshold in 1991 was 50 persons/20 households, in 2001 the threshold was 100 persons/40 households).
3. Where parishes are split by the National Park boundary and/or combined with others outside the boundary, an estimate has been made of the percentage in the Park.

Summary

Population decrease, possibly due to the closure of EshtonHall.

Small increase in the number of children.

Small increases in all three household sectors.

50% of tied houses have been lost since 1991. Decrease in second homes. Increase in outright ownership.

Economic activity rate stable.

Higher than National Park average employed in agriculture.

Managerial, professional and technical sectors are well represented compared to National Park average.

Car commuting equivalent to England and Wales level (higher than National Park average)

Very high levels of home workers.

Large increase in car numbers.

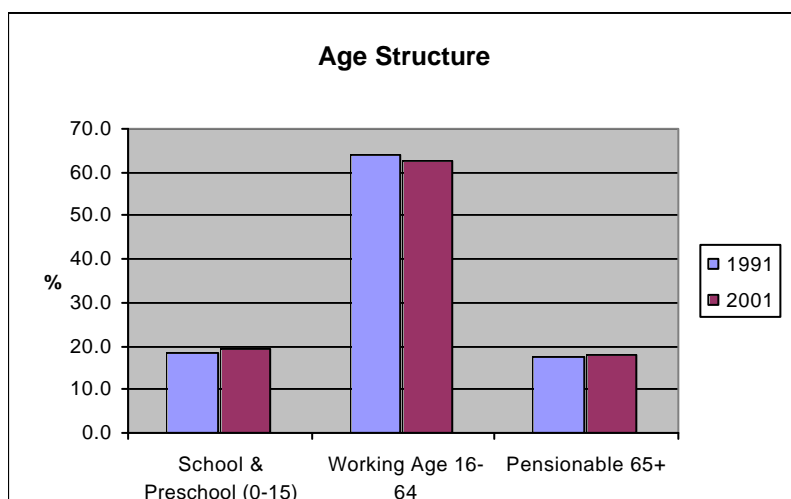
