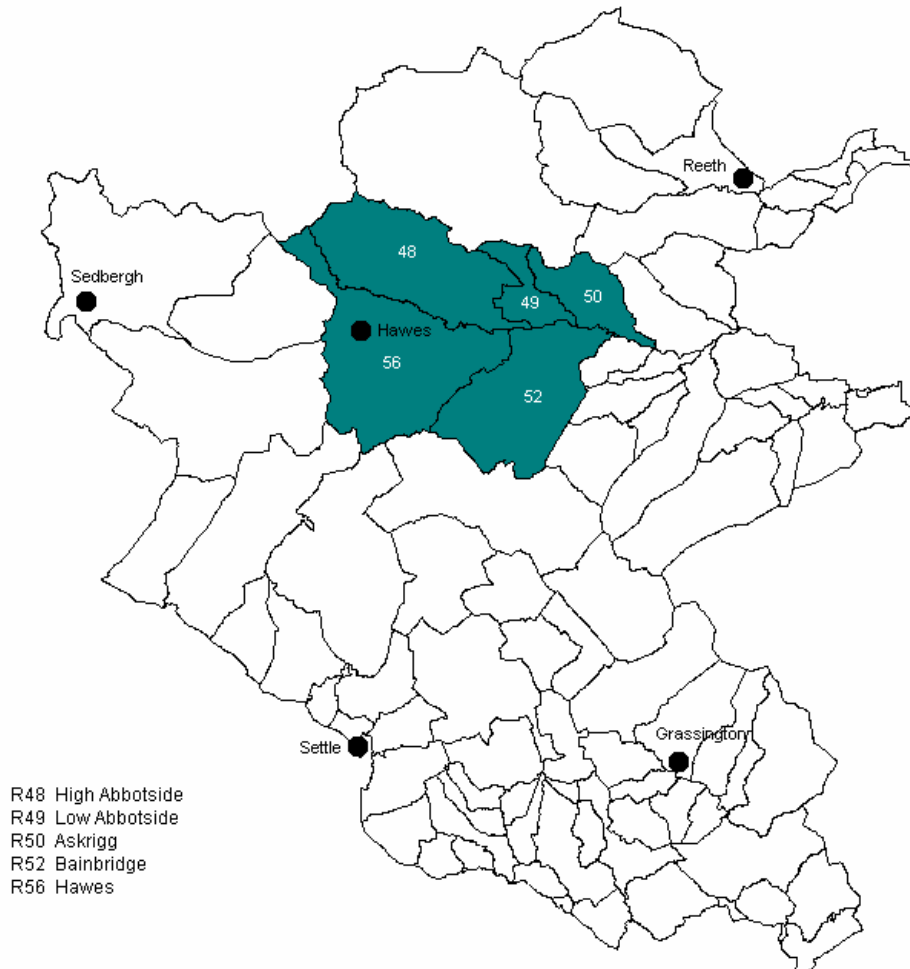




## UPPER WENSLEYDALE CENSUS PROFILE 1991-2001

(Parishes of Askrigg, Bainbridge, Hawes, High Abbotside, Low Abbotside)



### Notes

1. Figures may not sum due to independent rounding and adjustments to preserve confidentiality.
2. Any parish that falls below the confidentiality threshold for Small Area Statistics data is merged with a contiguous parish. (Confidentiality threshold in 1991 was 50 persons/20 households, in 2001 the threshold was 100 persons/40 households).
3. Where parishes are split by the National Park boundary and/or combined with others outside the boundary, an estimate has been made of the percentage in the Park.

### Summary

*Slight decline in population.*

*Reduction in the number and proportion of children*

More households yet a smaller population. Significantly less people are living in each dwelling. Despite a drop in the total number of children there are now 65 more households with children than in 1991.

Modest increase in the number of dwellings

Low proportion of mortgage purchases. Decline in Local Authority housing matched by increase in Housing Association stock

Slight increase in the number of second homes

Modest increase in economically active population, despite the A13 slight reduction in overall population.

Strong representation in hotels and catering, manufacture and construction

High representation in trades and process

Lower than National Park average representation in technical and professional occupations.

Higer than average proportion of the population walk to work or work at home. Low proportion of people commute by car.

A decline in the number of households without cars

250 more cars (24.3%) in Upper Wensleydale since 1991

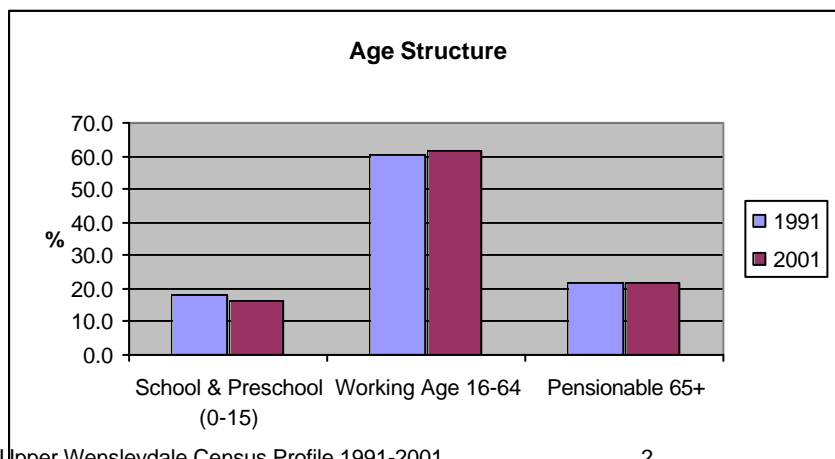
