

## **Hawes to the Wensleydale Creamery**

**Grid reference: SD 874898 to SD 870895**

### **Trail**

This 450m linear route follows the Pennine Way from the church in Hawes to the Wensleydale Creamery. The first 70m of the trail are cobbled with a gradient of 1:7. After this point, the footpath levels out with some slight gradients up to 1:10. Most of the length is constructed of stone flags at a width of 100cm. There is a rest area half way along the route.

### **Toilets**

The nearest public toilets, including RADAR facility toilets, are at the Hawes National Park Centre.

### **Parking**

There are numerous places to park within Hawes. There is a free car park along the main street. There are also disabled parking bays at the Hawes National Park Centre.

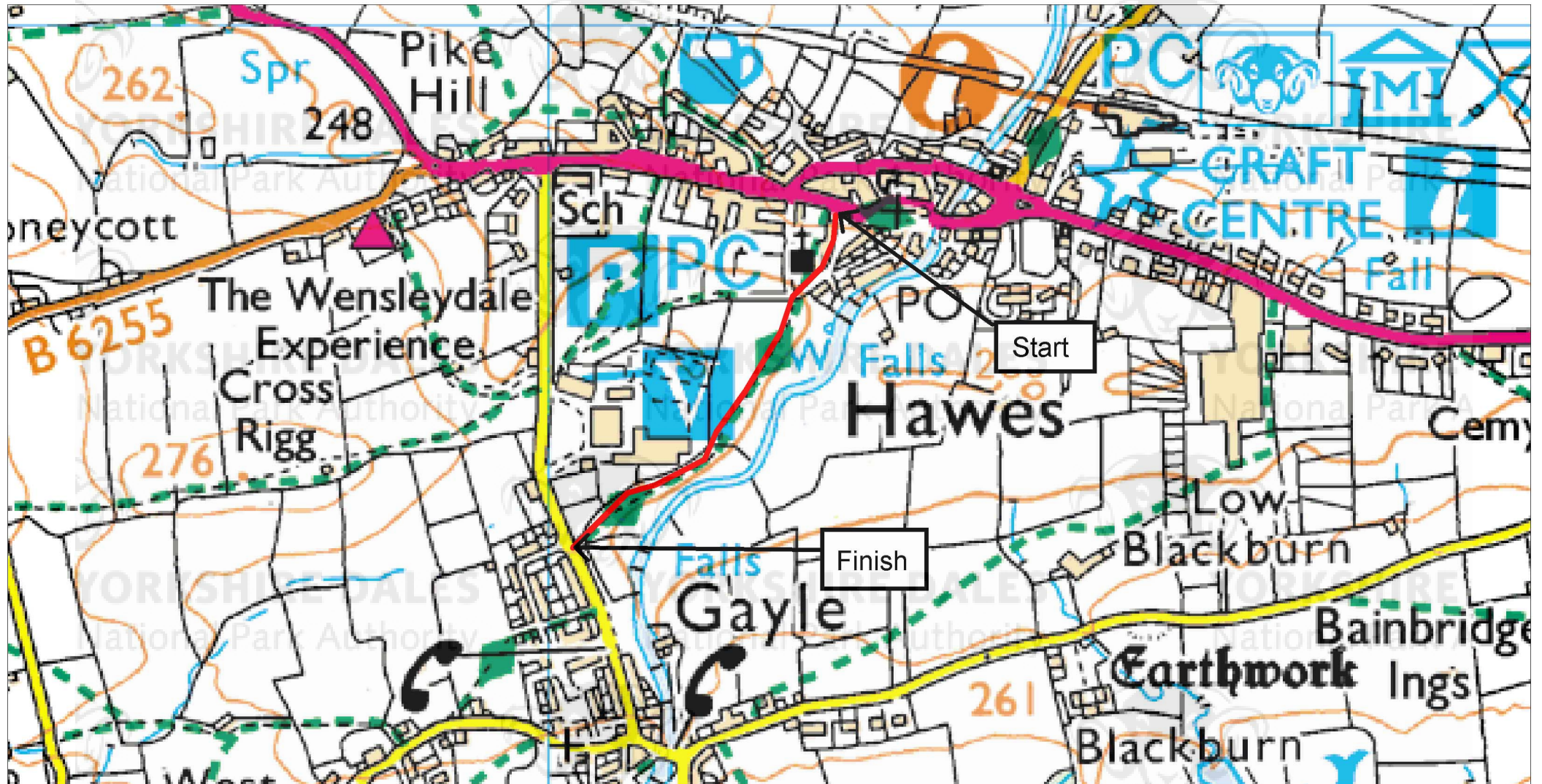
